

Arena Information

- Floor Size
 - Wall to wall 90' x 120'
- Rigging
 - East/West beams on 30' centers run the width of the arena
 - One center North/South beam runs the length of the arena
 - Cannot be used for any rigging
 - All rigging steel is 87' above the arena floor
 - Each beam can hold a maximum weight of 20,000lbs, with a per point maximum of 5,000lbs.
- Obstructions
 - (1) 30' x 25' center scoreboard

House Set Ups

- We are able to set the arena into many different configurations to meet specific event needs and specifications. There is retractable seating around the entire 100 level that can be used in various ways to accommodate production needs and maximize seating.

Spotlights

- (2) 2.5K Xenon Gladiator IIs located in the North arena catwalk
- (4) 2K Super Troupers located two each on the East and West catwalks and one located on the South catwalk
- (2) Lycian 400 Superarcs for portable usage and use from the concourse level of the arena
- Forklift
 - (1) Doosan GC25E-5LP with a 5,000lb load capacity
 - ▶ 14' lift & (1) Set of 5' fork extensions
- Genie Lift
 - Battery powered Genie Industrial Work Platform with a 30' maximum height

Staging


- (100) 4'x 8' sections of SICO stage
 - ► Height adjustable from 4' to 6' in 6" increments
- (6) 4' x 8' sound wings
 - ► Height adjustable from 4' to 6' in 6" increments
- (30) 4'x 8'x 16" risers
- (6) 4'x 8'x 8" risers
- Barricade
 - (20) sections free-standing StageRight blow thru barricade
 - (40) 8' sections of bicycle rack barricade

Show power – Southwest arena wall

- (1) 600amp, 208 volt, 5 wire service
- (2) 200amp, 208 volt, 5 wire service
- (1) 400amp, 208 volt, 5 wire service
- Additional power access hall at Northwest end of arena
 - (1) 200amp, 208 volt, 5 wire service
- We do not have any shore power
- House rigging equipment
 - ▶ 150′ 14″ triangle truss
 - 150' 12" TomCat ladder truss
 - ▶ 150′ 18″ Rhon tower triangle truss
 - ▶ (9) 1 ton CM motors
 - (6) Block and fall systems
 - Varying lengths

- Arena sound & video equipment
 - The arena is equipped with a state of the art sound system, which is fully programmable for all available seating configurations
 - It has a center-hung Panasonic video cluster
 - Any use of either systems must be advanced prior to arrival
- House Communication System
 - Clear-Com is hardwired to all spotlight positions, house light and house sound control
 - Patch panels available in the southeast, southwest and centerwest arena vomitories
 - Belt packs and headsets available for up to (10) positions
 - ▶ (5) Wired
 - ► (5) Wireless

Parking & Loading Entrance




Loading Area

- 15' x 16' roll-up door in the Southwest corner of the arena.
- Any equipment requiring a loading height greater than 14' must be advanced in order to adjust the interior curtain clearance.
- Loading for additional trucks is possible through three (2) 13' 6" H x 10' W doors in a backstage area located 40' South of the main load-in door.
 - Direct passage to the arena from this location is restricted by a width of 6' 10".
- Due to ice floor piping and grate, semi-trucks are not allowed on the arena floor at any time.

Dressing Rooms

- (1) Production office
- (4) Performer dressing rooms (Aux 1 4)
 - Private restroom and shower in each room
 - Each set of rooms has an air wall that can be opened to become one larger room
- (1) Office/green room
- (2) Locker rooms
- Other meeting rooms and team rooms may be available for rental, as needed, for additional office or reception space.

Walk-Through Metal Detectors

- We utilize (20) Garrett
 PD 6500i walk-through metal detectors
- They are placed at patron entrances for ticketed events and for all events that would normally do bag checks
- All metal detectors are ADA-compliant
